Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No


Comments: The UAA was conducted in July 2005 and no WBCR was observed. Livestock watering use was observed. The stream met the maximum depth criterion in 2 sites evaluated. Due to meeting the depth criteria, the committee recommends that WBCR designation be retained. Due to evidence of secondary contact recreation (SCR), the committee recommends that the SCR use be assigned.
