Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in April 2008 and no evidence of WBCR was observed. RV/ATV tracks were observed. Interviews conducted during a 2005 UAA cite swimming and fishing occurring along this segment. No interviews were conducted during 2008 UAA.


Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No

Comments: The stream met the maximum depth criterion at 2 of 5 sites. Because the maximum depth criterion was met and there is evidence of existing WBCR use, the committee recommends that the WBCR use be retained. Due to existing secondary contact recreation (fishing), the committee recommends that the secondary contact recreation use be assigned.
