Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in August 2008 and no WBCR was observed. The 2005 UAA provided 23 comments that swimming, wading, fishing, baptisms had occurred since 1975. No interviews were conducted during this survey.

Is the evaluated use attainable? Yes No

Comments: The stream did not meet the maximum or median depth criteria for WBCR. No interviews were given in 2008 UAA. Based on the comments received in 2005, the committee recommends that WBCR be retained and SCR be added.
