Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in August 2008 and no WBCR was observed. No interviews were conducted during this survey.

Is the evaluated use attainable?  Yes  No

Comments: The stream did not meet the maximum depth or median depth criteria at any of the locations for WBCR. According to surveyors this looked like an irrigation ditch with deep muddy slopes and bottom. It was also only accessible through a farmer's field. No interviews were given in 2008 UAA. Based on the information provided, the committee recommends that WBCR be removed.
