Comments: The UAA survey was conducted in August 2008 and there was no WBCR observed. There was a rope swing located at site #2 of the survey. Also, there was a private campground at site #3 of the survey. There was an interview conducted that cited swimming, tubing and fishing along the classified segment for over 50 years. A 2005 UAA also noted fishing tackle along the creek.

Is the evaluated use attainable?  Yes  No

Comments: The stream met the maximum depth criterion at 1 of 3 locations for WBCR. There were also multiple pools of >1 meter deep along the classified segment. Due to the depth criterion being met and multiple signs of WBCR and SCR use, the committee recommends that WBCR be retained and SCR be added.
