Beginning Aug. 28, 2009 and updated Aug. 28, 2012, shipments of radioactive materials are subject to a fee when traveling in or through the state of Missouri. *NOTE: "Shipper" is defined as the generator, owner or company contracting for transportation by truck or rail of the high-level radioactive waste, transuranic radioactive waste, Highway Route Controlled Quantity shipments, spent nuclear fuel or low-level radioactive waste through or within the state of Missouri.
