- The Missouri Asbestos Exam is specific to the Missouri asbestos regulations and is in addition to the occupation-specific test given by your training provider.
- If you are required to take the Missouri Asbestos Exam, submit the \$25 fee with this application.
- Only submit one Missouri Asbestos Exam fee if you are applying for certification in more than one occupation.
- You do not have to submit the Missouri Asbestos Exam fee if you are currently certified in Missouri in another asbestos occupation.
- If your asbestos refresher training certificate has been expired for more than one year, you must retake and pass the Missouri Asbestos Exam and submit the \$25 exam fee with this application.

Required for Initial and Renewal Certification

Submit two recent passport-style color photographs (without hat or sunglasses) per application. **Computer-generated, photocopied or old photographs are not acceptable, and they will delay the processing of your application.**

PART V — REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION FOR INITIAL CERTIFICATION

Submit the training certificate and supplemental information listed **for initial certification** under the occupation for which you are applying. This documentation is required by the following regulations: Chapter 643 RSMo and Missouri asbestos regulation 10 CSR 10-6.250.

WORKER

- Copy of initial certificate for worker training from a Missouri-accredited training provider*

SUPERVISOR

- Copy of initial certificate for supervisor training from a Missouri-accredited training provider* **AND**
 Letter from employer verifying at least one year of experience in asbestos abatement or general construction

INSPECTOR

- Copy of initial certificate for inspector training from a Missouri-accredited training provider* **AND**
 Proof of high school graduation or equivalent**

MANAGEMENT PLANNER

- Copy of initial certificate for management planner training from a Missouri-accredited training provider* **AND**
 Copy of credentials proving current certification as an asbestos inspector in Missouri AND
 Proof of high school graduation or equivalent**

PROJECT DESIGNER (Provide supplemental information requested in either Group A or B, below)

- A. Copy of initial certificate for project designer training from a Missouri-accredited training provider* **AND**
 Proof of Bachelor of Science in engineering or industrial hygiene. Provide college transcripts. **AND**
 A self-certifying letter of working knowledge of heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) systems **OR**
- B. Copy of initial certificate for project designer training from a Missouri-accredited training provider* **AND**
 Proof of high school graduation or equivalent** **AND**
 Letter from employer verifying at least four years of experience in either building design or HVAC systems

AIR SAMPLING PROFESSIONAL (Provide supplemental information requested in Group A, B, C, D or E, below)

- A. Proof of Bachelor of Science in industrial hygiene and a letter verifying one year of field experience **AND**
Provide a copy of your diploma, a certified copy of your college transcript and documentation of one year of experience. **OR**
- B. Proof of Master of Science in industrial hygiene. Provide a copy of your diploma and certified copy of college transcript. **OR**
- C. Proof of certification as an industrial hygienist from the American Board of Industrial Hygiene (ABIH). Provide a copy of the ABIH certificate and a certified copy of your college transcript. **OR**
- D. Proof of three years of field experience in practical industrial hygiene and completion of a 40-hour asbestos course (NIOSH 582 or equivalent) that includes air monitoring instruction. The field experience should include significant asbestos air monitoring. At least 50% of the three-year period must have been on projects in which a degreed or certified industrial hygienist or Missouri-certified air sampling professional was involved. You must provide a written reference from the industrial hygienist or the asbestos air sampling professional stating your performance of air monitoring was acceptable and that you are capable of fulfilling the responsibilities associated with certification as an asbestos air sampling professional. You must also provide documentation of experience and a copy of the asbestos course certificate. **OR**
- E. Proof of other qualifications, including, but not limited to, an ABIH-accepted degree or a health/safety-related degree combined with related experience. You should include a copy of your diploma and/or certification, a certified copy of college transcript(s) and letters necessary to verify experience. (The type of degree considered eligible is subject to approval by the director of the Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Air Pollution Control Program.)

* If your initial training certificate has expired, you must include a copy of all refresher certificate(s), the most recent of which must be from a Missouri-accredited training provider. If you are licensed in another state, you may meet this requirement by submitting a copy of your current out-of-state license **AND** a copy of your certificate proving current refresher training from a Missouri-accredited training provider.

** Acceptable proof of high school graduation includes a copy of your high school diploma or GED, a copy of your college diploma or a copy of your high school or college transcripts.

The department's Air Pollution Control Program will process applications on a first-come, first-served basis.

Submit a separate application form for each occupation for which you want to be certified.

The director of the Air Pollution Control Program will send an applicant's credentials only when the program has received all fees and all information requested on this form.

Applicants may consider themselves certified when they have received their credentials from the director.

Allow two weeks for processing from date of receipt by the Air Pollution Control Program.

The Air Pollution Control Program will send credentials via the U.S. Postal Service to the address provided on the application. Additional copies are your responsibility.
