

EMISSIONS TESTING

New Testing Program Began Oct. 1

The Gateway Vehicle Inspection Program began Oct. 1. Motorists can visit a licensed auto shop of their choice to have an emissions test and safety inspection performed on their vehicle. All 1996 and newer vehicles equipped with an on board diagnostic computer, called OBD, registered in the St. Louis nonattainment area will be subject to an emissions test and safety inspection. OBD is an early warning system that monitors the emission control devices of the vehicle. Vehicles will pass or fail the emissions test based on the OBD results. Look for a new emissions testing location near you.

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources and the Missouri State Highway Patrol jointly administer the Gateway Vehicle Inspection Program. The program is a key component of the ongoing effort to improve air quality in the St. Louis region.
