





Generalized Occurrence of Missouri Limestone

-  Limestone Deeply Buried Beneath Tertiary-Cretaceous Rock Strata
-  Relatively Thin Calcite Limestone Units Alternating with Shale Units in Pennsylvanian Rock Strata
-  Thick Calcite Limestone and Dolomitic Limestone in Mississippian-Devonian-Middle Ordovician Strata
-  Thick Dolomite and Calcitic Dolomite in Lower Ordovician-Cambrian Rock Strata
-  Limestone Absent Basal Cambrian Sandstone and underlying Precambrian Igneous Rocks
