Membership Composition

Missouri Weatherization Policy Advisory Council membership shall reflect the relevant groups whom the program represents, in particular low-income households, especially those that include the elderly, the physically disadvantaged and families with children. Membership shall include, but not limited to, advocates of the Low-Income Weatherization Assistance Program clientele who manage or deliver LIWAP program services, or who participate in or have a history of activities advocating low-income interests, or are recipients or eligible recipients of the Low-Income Weatherization Assistance Program. One member shall be elected by council members. Considerations shall be given to geographic and equitable representation of the state.

Terms

All appointments shall be for a term of three program years with three members' terms expiring each year. Reappointments shall be at the discretion of the director of the Division of Energy.

Geographic Consideration

Statewide.

Responsibilities of the Commission/Members

The council shall meet at least twice each year to consider the development of the subsequent year's Low-Income Weatherization Assistance Program State Plan and the implementation and general status of the Low-Income Weatherization Assistance Program.
