



Missouri Certified Home Energy Auditor Application, Provisional Certification Instructions for Form 780-2012

1. This application form is only for those individuals that do not have BPI or RESNET certification and may or may not have had some formal training in home energy audits. The certification is based primarily on experience.
2. The department recognizes some individuals who currently conduct home energy audits in Missouri do not have a BPI, RESNET, or other training institution certification and may not have sufficient time to obtain one of these certifications by January 1, 2009. In recognition of these circumstances, the department will issue provisional Missouri Home Energy Auditor certification to individuals that have at least two years experience as home energy auditors. The Provisional Certification is for a one year period and may not be renewed.
3. The application form, section *Training/Experience*, instructs the applicant to attach several items related to operating a business. If the applicant is operating a Home Energy Auditor or related business, the applicant should attach as many of the items as are available to help establish the authenticity of the experience claimed in the application.
4. The individual seeking certification must check with the local city and county to determine whether a business license is required. The individual must check with the Secretary of State's office to determine if business name registration is required. If a license or business name registration is required and the individual does not have them, the department will not issue a certification. The Missouri Business Portal, a single point of entry for business registration, filings, licenses and permits for doing business in the State of Missouri is located at: www.business.mo.gov
5. The department will provide individuals applying for certification as Missouri Home Energy Auditors (Provisional) with information regarding Health and Safety standards for home energy audits, and will require a signed statement that the applicant has read and understands the information.
